

ORDINANCE 18-448

AN ORDINANCE OUTLINING PERMISSIBLE DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS
ON AND AROUND JULY 4th EACH YEAR

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the citizens of the Town of Julesburg to establish consistent guidelines for the time and dates of permissible fireworks within the town's limits so that public peace may prevail and give structure to those wishing to celebrate the holiday in a manner consistent with the statutes of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the current Ordinance regarding the discharge of fireworks in the Town of Julesburg town limits is currently inconsistent with, and impermissible for citizens to follow in the State of Colorado;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Julesburg Board of Trustees, Town of Julesburg Code Chapter 9.24.030 should be and hereby is modified as follows, to wit:

9.24.030 Fireworks

- A. No person shall do any of the following acts: ignite, cause to be ignited or set off, any rocket, missile or other dangerously combustible material; provided, however, this cause shall not apply to the activities duly sanctioned and authorized by the Town, taking place within the hours of 9:00 am and 11:00 pm beginning three days prior to the fourth of July of each year, to ending on the fourth of July, on these designated dates as allowable by Colorado Law. Nothing in this ordinance shall allow any individual to ignite, cause to be ignited or set off, any firework, rocket, missile or other dangerously combustible material that is not a permissible firework pursuant to the laws of the State of Colorado.
