

A Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees was held on Wednesday, January 26, 2022. Members present when this meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Sherman at 7:00 p.m. included Trustees Mast, Law, Wall, Campbell and Lanckriet as well as Clerk Hartwell, Manager Nein and Attorney Wells. Mayor Hoschouer was excused from the meeting. A quorum was present, and the meeting could proceed after the Pledge of Allegiance. Guests utilized a sign-in sheet to record their attendance of the meeting and News Correspondent Vickie Sandlin live streamed the meeting.

Guest Kurt Hodel was requested by Mayor Pro-Tem Sherman to give a presentation regarding any considerations the Board Members should be aware of when drafting an ordinance to allow marijuana sales in the community. Several points of consideration were enumerated by Guest Hodel and included the allocation of tax revenue, architectural restrictions, safety, traffic and parking, and zoning for a non-conforming business.


Trustee Campbell reiterated the Board Members are not here this evening to decide whether or not the Town will lift the current moratorium on marijuana, but to educate ourselves on what needs to be outlined in a sample ordinance and have available when needed.

Attorney Wells led discussion among the Board Members on the items that need to be in the sample ordinance.


Mayor Pro-Tem Sherman invited public comments from those persons who requested to be on the agenda. Guest Danielle Bonney spoke in favor of allowing marijuana sales. Guests Mike Benson, Ivy Joy Johnson, and Jim Kontny spoke in opposition to allow marijuana sales.

After further Board discussion, Trustee Law made a motion and seconded by Trustee Campbell to direct Attorney Wells to research and draft the beginnings of a sample ordinance. Vote was unanimous.

There being no additional business, a motion was made by Trustee Mast and seconded by Trustee Wall at 9:05 pm for adjournment.
